There was a lot of excitement to find their new classrooms, new bench mates and new teachers too. Yes, we have increased in student strength and educators.

As a parent, you might be wondering, we are already closing on this month and yet the academic engine has not picked up pace as you all had expected. Well, let me enlighten you on how things are shaping up in the classroom.

Our students made us realise this from their thoughts as they eagerly narrated their summer breaks to their friends as well as their teachers. As a teacher, it is equally important to establish a dialogue with your students. We need to hear them out and let them state their opinion. Gone are the days where it was a monologue in the classroom with only the teacher holding the centre stage.

We felt it is imperative to listen to our children and connect with them. Entire week 1 was a transition week. It was a week that needed every teacher to bond with every child in her class. Gearing up on lessons directly would have closed the doors to connect with children.

"Revise to be Wise"

It was this mantra which we followed. We moved from Known to unknown, a common practice suggested in teaching pedagogy. This is where we tried to recollect, revise, recapitulate on the content which we learnt / studied last year. It was like strengthening the foundation of our academic building which needs to be multistored this year. Revision pattern was a fun way to play games, watch videos, and solve some online quizzes. Appropriate use of interactive panels (technology driven) was made, we being an ultramodern Gurukul. This made sure the entire class was involved in the revision sessions.

For our grade 1 students this was a huge transition. Check on the changes which these tiny tots underwent .

- School routine which were merely 3 hours earlier extended to 6 hours.
- One teacher throughout the day to many teachers all through the day.
- Eating only one meal to having food twice a day that too wholemeal
- Sitting in only one class to exploring a new classroom for every period
- Only one activity in a day to multiple activities in a day
- Knowing the whole class of 20 students to adjust to new friends in a batch of 40!



As an adult , we take time to adjust to such robust changes. Wouldn't it be unfair to expect a smooth hassle free transition for our tiny tots! They might be the biggest class in Pre - Primary, but now suddenly they are the youngest ones in the Primary Section. It was thus very important that we acclimatise our children before we start on the core academic content. As we are looking for academic growth in every literate child.

Academic growth caters whole needs of an individual - Like physical, social, emotional and spiritual while literacy just says that an individual can read and write well. These transitions occur multiple times in a child's schooling journey. You will find it with students who moved from grade 2 to grade 3 and grade 5 to grade 6. Their school routine and time too has changed. They started exploring hobbies with external resources and sports in a different way.

Entire 3 weeks' journey for us was to ensure children are able to stay connected inspite of change and feel as a part of the new classroom with new teachers and friends. Learning can happen better provided the learning environment is equally conducive. All these things are gradually acclimatising and we now walk more confidently towards the coming month.

"Ashadi Ekadasi celebrated in an innovative and unique way "

Indian culture is the collection of social norms and ethical values, so how can PGKM school which is an Ultra Modern Gurukul not trail it.

Ashadi Ekadasi was celebrated in an innovative and unique way in school. It was celebrated for a week conducting 'Bhakti movement' including various activities conducted by teachers and students. In the entire week all teachers integrated their studies with the bhakti movement. In Maths teachers taught word problems, where questions were inspired by the word problems related to Warkari sampradaya - Warkari's route, distance, time etc. In Science, germination, various diseases, prevention and cure were discussed. In all languages, information of various saints- their origins, history, their work of art like abhangas, bhajans and dohas were taught.

In the student's enterprise time, students explored their creativity and made patakas, Vitthal drawing with Mandala art, composed abhangas and dohas, and did sponge painting of Lord Vitthal. On the day of Ashadi Ekadashi, a small program was arranged where a drama on 'Narhari Sonar' was presented along with various abhangas, dohas of Sant Kabir, and information of various saints was given. 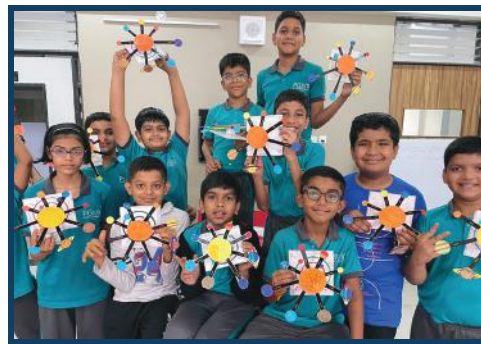
17 Hobby Courses activated in Term 1

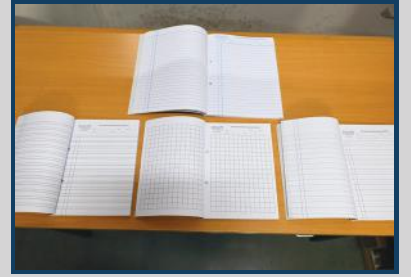
