#### After high tea the meeting commenced!

We began by briefing parents about how the education field is changing according to the **NEP 2020**. Stressing upon the need to move away from the traditional schooling methods which were in force in India since 1986, parents were made to realise that it was time to move towards modern learning methods which involve experiential learning.

- It was stressed upon, how PGKM is a NEP enabled, child centric, activity-based school where focus is more on learning outcomes than just completing the portions.
- We look at English as a language skill and not a mere subject which is to be studied at school. It is not just a medium for conducting exams but it is a language which needs to be developed for better communication and expression.
- After introducing the Gurukul textbook series which is tailor-made for the children, keeping in mind the outcome-based curriculum, it was explained how these books were made by choosing the best content out of various publications.
- We addressed the various questions that the parents had in their minds regarding academics, canteen, water facility, infrastructure, dispersals etc.
- There was a consensus on taking some action against the garbage accumulation outside the school premises, the traffic congestions and the potholes on the roads adjacent to the school.
- An appeal was made to the parents for extending respect and decent behaviour towards the school staff.

The meeting concluded on an amiable note and followed by dinner which everyone enjoyed.





## Communicate to connect better, or connect to communicate better!

We humans in the course of evolution developed languages through signs and symbols. They were purely a means of communication. Voice out one's thoughts, feelings, messages and many more. However, the true core of the same remained as a mode to hear me out.

This development happened better in a country like India. Our diverse culture led to formation of many vernacular languages pertaining to the area where we dwelled. With Sanskrit to be the mother of the majority of languages in India.

Knowledge creation, literature scripts, administrative SOP's were developed as per need of the emerging societies. With globalisation, we got exposed to many languages spoken all over the world. Due to a long-term British impact, we started communicating in English which somehow was accepted and suddenly we all started thinking that's how communication works, and that's how the world connects.



"Wah! What fine English does a person speak" is a general comment which we started imposing on each other. Nevertheless, realising that it is the thought which needs to be appreciated and not the language in which it is spoken.

Wise men say, if you want to make a person understand something from his heart, you need to speak in the language that connects to his heart and in such cases, it is the mother tongue which creates a long-lasting impression. Language even today is a primary tool for expressions which happens to make us connect faster.

To exude the magic of emotions we often refer back to our mother tongue. And then suddenly we might say, Ahh... now this person speaks so apt! It just touches my soul!

Bauj saras waat kidhi!! Bauj mast!!

With the same thought in education, NCF (National Curriculum Framework) proposes to connect with students in the language they understand the best during their foundational years. That's when they find school and teachers as one of their family members and get strongly bonded. That is how they would love the concept and get engrossed in knowing English as a language and not merely as a subject guarded by grammar soldiers.

Learning English has more to do with "connecting to communicate better" than "communicating to connect" these days. To motivate students to converse in fluent English we thought of implementing a new policy from the month of August itself. Every language is based on four strong pillars. Precisely listening, speaking, reading and writing. Mastering these skills is important to achieve full command over that language. We plan to create several opportunities for students launching a program "English Hinglish".



# "ENGLISH HINGLISH"



Sharing few highlights of the "English Hinglish" program with you:

- Listening skill Audio books, Alexa enabled classrooms, Podcast, Interviews.
- Speaking skill Extempore, Object talk.
- Reading skill Read newspaper, articles, notices, books etc. from the library to be read and write a Book Review.
- Writing skill Maintaining a diary, writing stories, composing poems.
- Effective use of poetry to know various intonations in English language.

In addition to this, the class which converses in English all the time – be it corridor, canteen or turf would be awarded a brownie point as special acknowledgement.

So dear parents, do not worry if your child has not yet started narrating all that happens in school in English!

Appreciate if your child comes home to tell you he/she has learnt a new thing today. So, what if it is currently in another language!

Very soon you will find your child more confident and fluent in thoughts and definitely will be able to communicate efficiently in English as well as in other vernacular languages.

#### **Topic for Students - Health and Hygiene (Grade: 1 to 7)**

Children learn best when they are happy, stress - free and secure. School is a place for the child to feel all this and more. It is a home away from home. 

The "Parupp Payasam" isn't simply a culinary creation; it's a voyage into the heart of South Indian culture, a harmonious blend of Moong Dal, Jaggery, Ghee & Coconut Milk that speak the language of heritage and harmony. So, surrender to the temptation, let your taste buds revel in the magic of "Parupp Payasam," and experience the enchantment of a dessert that transcends time and place, leaving you craving for more."

Ingredients	Quantity
Moong Dal	1cup
Jaggery	1½cup
Water	1cup
Ghee	2tbsp
Thick Fresh Coconut Milk	1cup
Thin Fresh Coconut Milk	2½cup
Cashew nuts	45gms
Kishmish	45gms
Cardamon	4pods
Dry Ginger	1/4tsp



#### Instructions:

- 1. Heat 1 tbsp of Ghee and roast Moong Dal till a nice even brown colour which releases an earthy roasted aroma.
- 2. Now add the thin extract of Coconut Milk, bring the liquid to a boil and cook till dal is done (pressure cook for 1 whistle).
- 3. Boil 1 cup water on the side and dissolve the Jaggery in the water, reduce to half the volume strain and add to the Moong Dal and bring to a boil.
- 4. Add Thick Coconut milk extract and immediately remove the vessel from heat to avoid curdling.
- 5. Temper the Cashew nuts and Kishmish in remaining ghee and add to Payasam. Serve hot!
- · If using ready-made coconut milk
- 2 Tetra packs of 200ml each
- · 600ml water to be added to 200ml coconut milk for cooking dal
- · 200ml ready-made coconut to be added at the end as thick milk


#### Vaama Patel (7 th B)

#### Jiya Porwal (7th A)






## RFID-Enabled ID Cards implemented for Secure Dispersal of Students




# READ....KNOW....GROW





## **Tooth Fairy Day**


